DMS provided immediate support by contributing financial assistance for his medical expenses and the sponsor parents of his brother Bhim Raj BK, also helped the family economically.



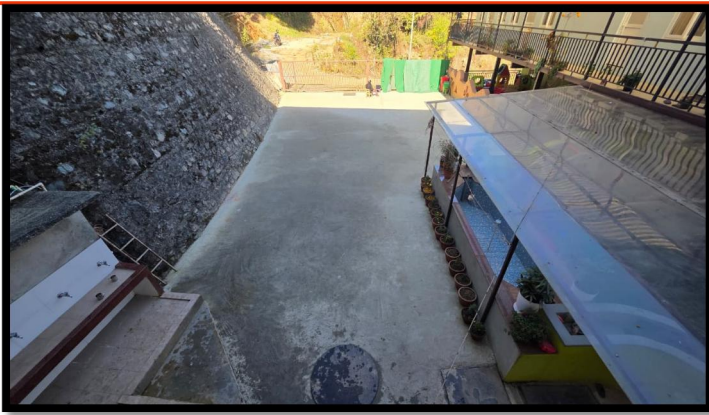
Claudio visit and his contribution

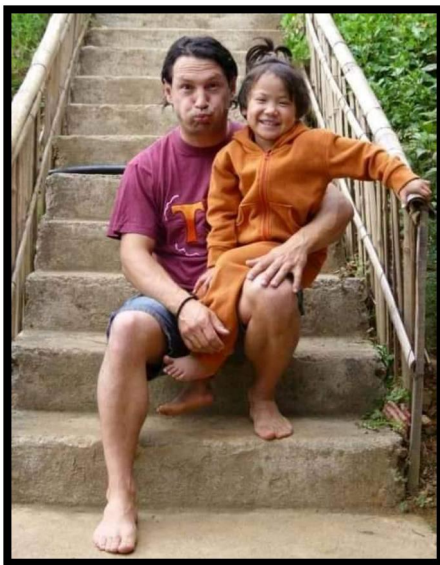
His visit and support reflect his continued commitment to the well being and development of DMS students.

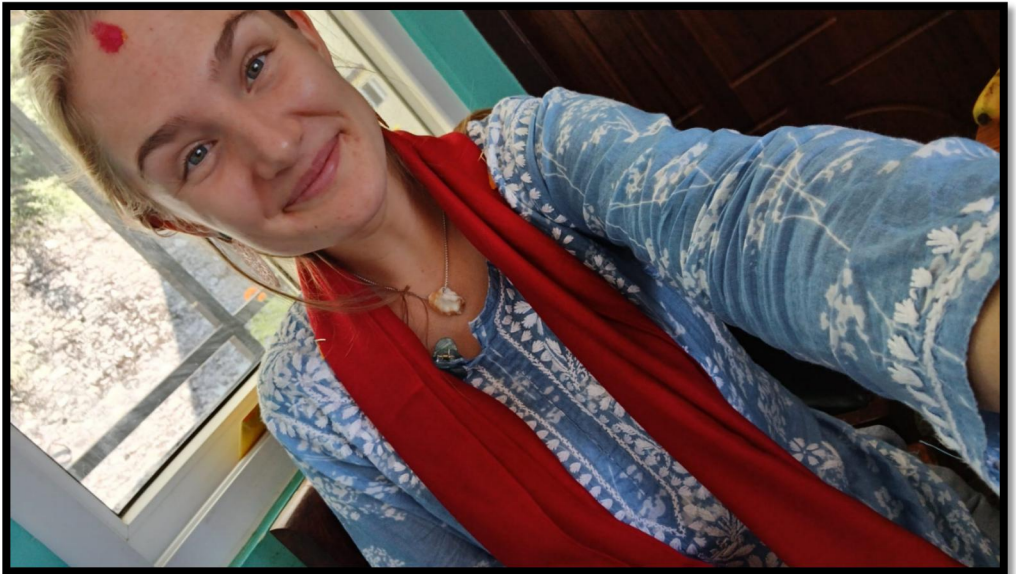
These activities provided students with opportunities for recreation, exploration and bonding outside the classroom.



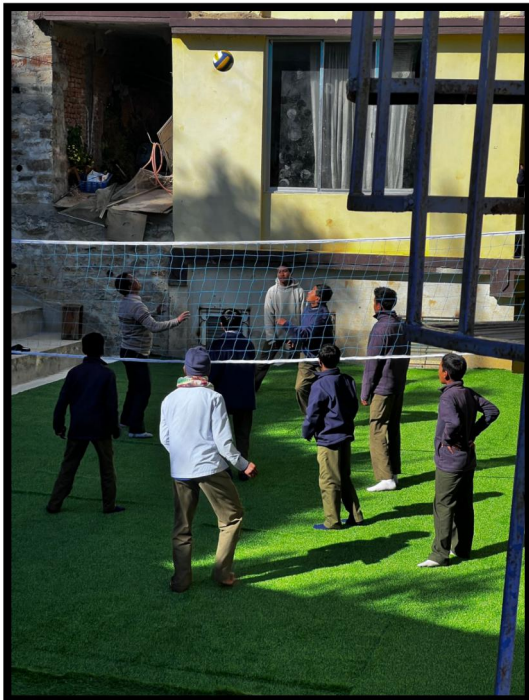


Volunteer visit
